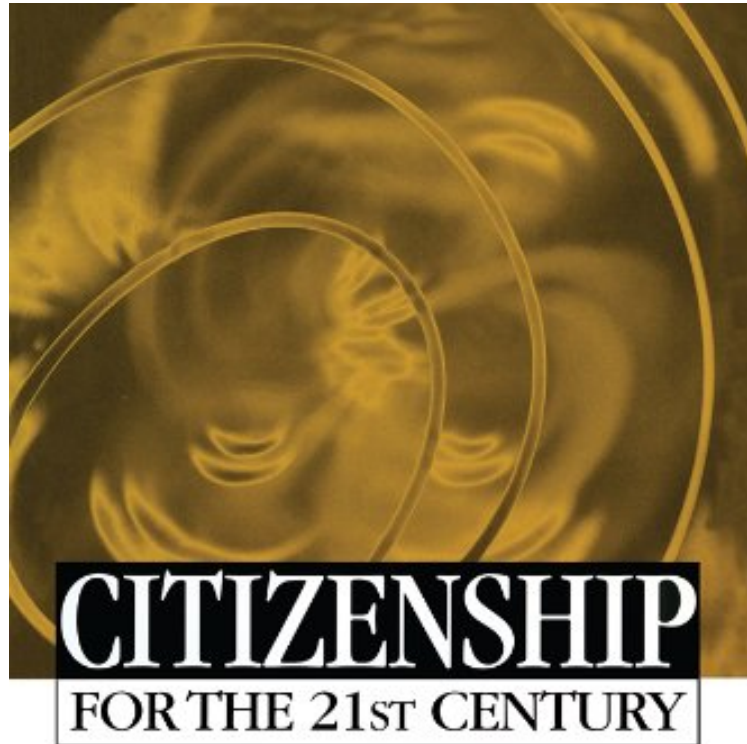

Based on the findings of a long-lasting, cross-cultural and cross-national study the book introduces a convincing theoretical model of citizenship and explains it in detail but though easily accessible for someone not familiar with the topic. The model is based on needs emerging from general trends in education and society as well as general global trends and therefore put into context. Finally the authors try to describe some ideas how this model could / should be implemented. And here the only criticism belongs to: The persons concerned, young people themselves, are forgotten, ignored, not taken into consideration. The book pinpoints at necessary reforms in teachers education as well as necessary political frames to be delivered for an educational reform, but how young people can contribute themselves to the development of citizenship education doesn't play a role - unfortunately. Still, the book is worthwhile reading!
