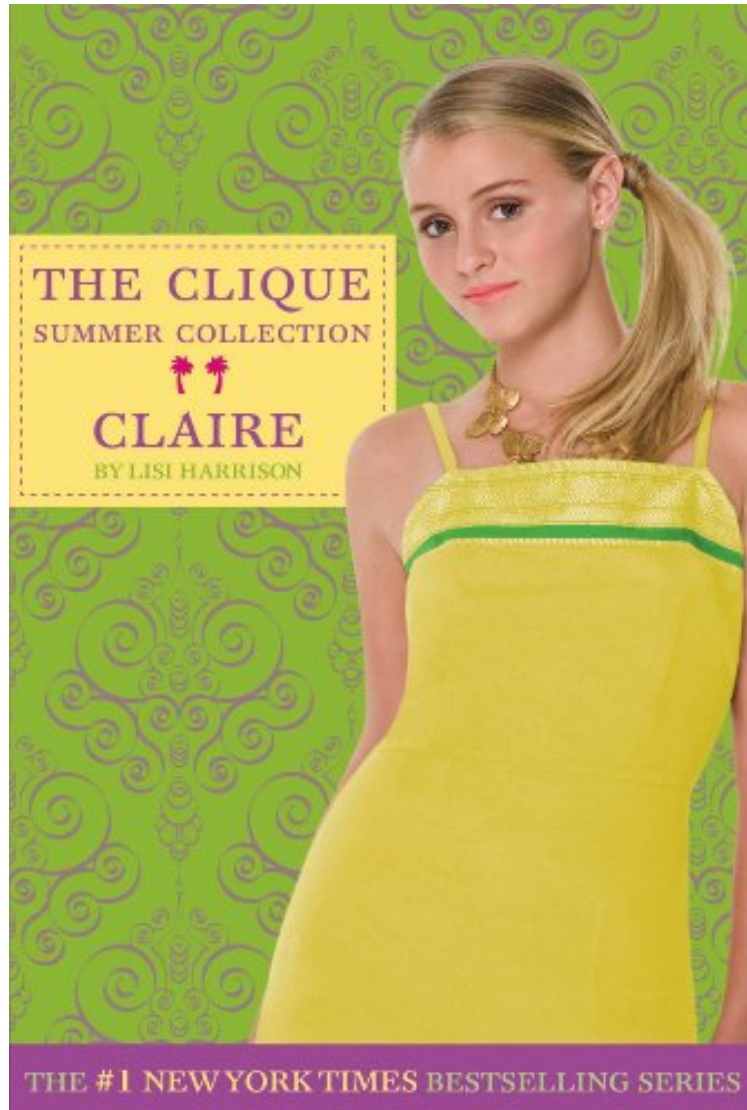

Good reading for teenage English students Von Bernhard Zoettl I am a private English teacher and bought the book because one of my students told me she loved the related TV series (or film?)... I hadn't heard of "The Clique" before, but I think that teens can relate to the story quite well. The style and language is OK, sometimes a few colloquial expressions try to make the dialogs more lively. One thing though: I believe that the book is not really suitable for (English-learning) students younger than 15/16 (that would be 9th or 10th grade) because the language and vocabulary is too complex for the average younger student.
