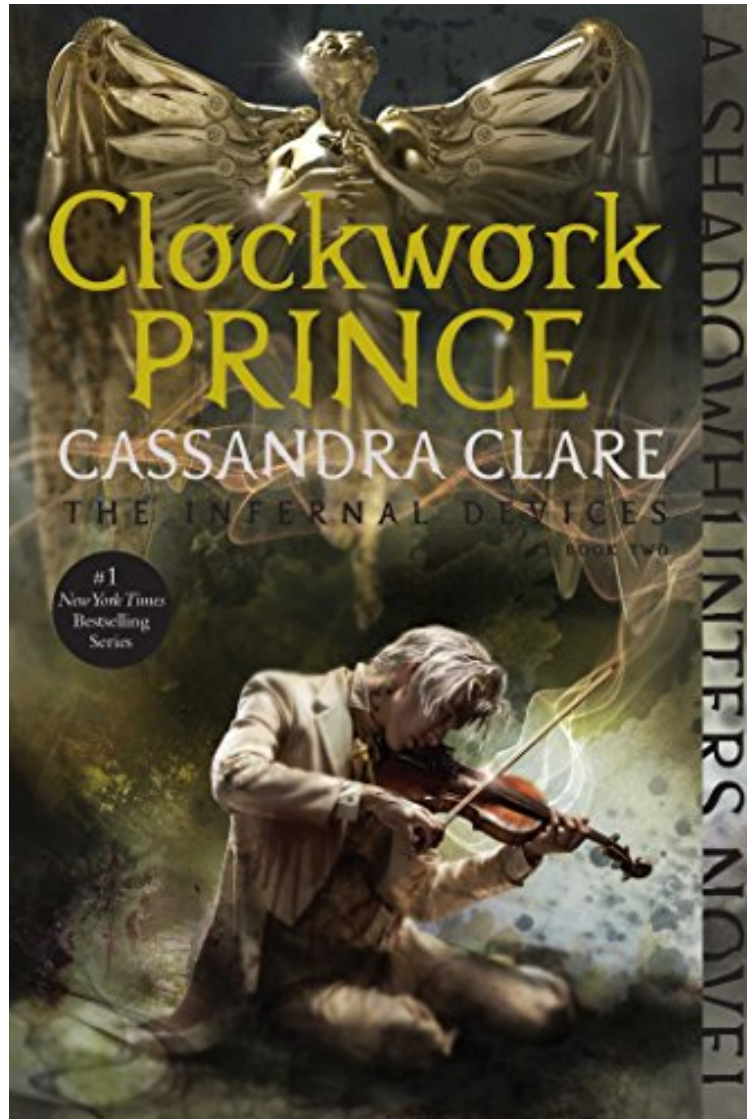

Manhwa-Adaption Von Gaia Seraphina*Dies ist die Manhwa-Adaption vom ersten Band mit dem Titel Clockwork Angel der Roman-Trilogie "Die Chroniken der Schattenjger". Da ich ein absoluter Fan der Romane von Cassandra Clare bin und ein ebenso grosser Manga-Liebhaber, musste ich mir natrlich sogleich diesen Band besorgen. Der Kauf hat sich absolut gelohnt. Die Adaption der Romanhandlung finde ich extrem gelungen. Natrlich wurden ein paar Dinge ein wenig verkrzt wiedergegeben, da der Roman ber 500 Seiten hat und in einem halb so dicken Manhwa-Band verarbeitet wurde. Doch wichtige Schlselzenen und die Darstellung der einzelnen Charaktere wurden gut bernommen. Der Zeichenstil von Frau Hyekyung Baek ist sehr schn anzuschauen (wenn auch nicht ganz so schn wie in der Manhwa-Adaption von "Twilight"). Der Shjo-Zeichenstil erinnert ein wenig an die Werke der Mangaka Kaoru Mori (Emma, Young Bride's Story). Fans der Roman-Vorlage sollten den Manhwa mal ausprobieren. Manhwa- bzw. Manga-Fans auch, sofern sie Geschichten mgen, die dem Erzhlstil von Kaori Yki (v.a. dem Manga God Child) hneln. Wer Earl Fairy mochte, fr den knnte der Manhwa auch lesenswert sein. Leider gibt es den Manhwa bisher nur auf englisch. PS: Demnchst wird auch eine Comic-Adaption von City of Bones (in englischer Sprache) erscheinen. Schade (fr mich), da es sich dabei nicht auch um einen Manga/Manhwa handelt (der asiatische Zeichenstil gefllt mir besser, als der amerikanische).

Comic books, mangas or even films based on a novel are always a bit difficult. You can never satisfy all the fans because everyone has different images of the characters. I gave Clockwork Angel a try because I used to read mangas and because I adore Cassandra Clare's books. I WON'T mention the content of the manga so this review is for the readers who've READ the first book of The Infernal Devices series. What I liked: The buildings: the exterior and interior of the Institute (the library looked amazing) or the meeting place of the Pandemonium Club. Brother Enoch: wow. He looked amazing and so creepy! I cannot wait to see more of the Silent Brothers in the City of Bones movie. The interludes when the characters mostly Will and Tessa didnt look like their usual manga selves but almost like chibi versions. The automatons: they looked great, so realistic but still devoid of any emotion. Tessa: she was so pretty and I absolutely loved her hair. To be honest all the girls had great hair in the manga! Will (so adorable as a little boy) and Jem: Good luck, Tessa! I know I wouldnt be able to make a decision between these two when they look so handsome. The kiss: I dont think I have to elucidate. What I disliked: The way a few characters (Henry, Charlotte and Magnus) were drawn. I was disappointed, I admit it. I wont elaborate because you can see for yourselves if you decide to buy the manga. Unfortunately, you dont start at the other end of the book (the usual manga reading style) but at the left end like a conventional comic book. I would have preferred to read it like a real manga, from right to left. SPOILER! No A TALE OF TWO CITIES. For me the book is a very important part of The Infernal Devices and I was sad that it wasnt mentioned when Will and Tessa are in the Institutes library. You can definitely read the Clockwork Angel manga without having read the book but I'd also read it because you'll get to know the characters' thoughts, certain things are more detailed and simply because it's a great book!
