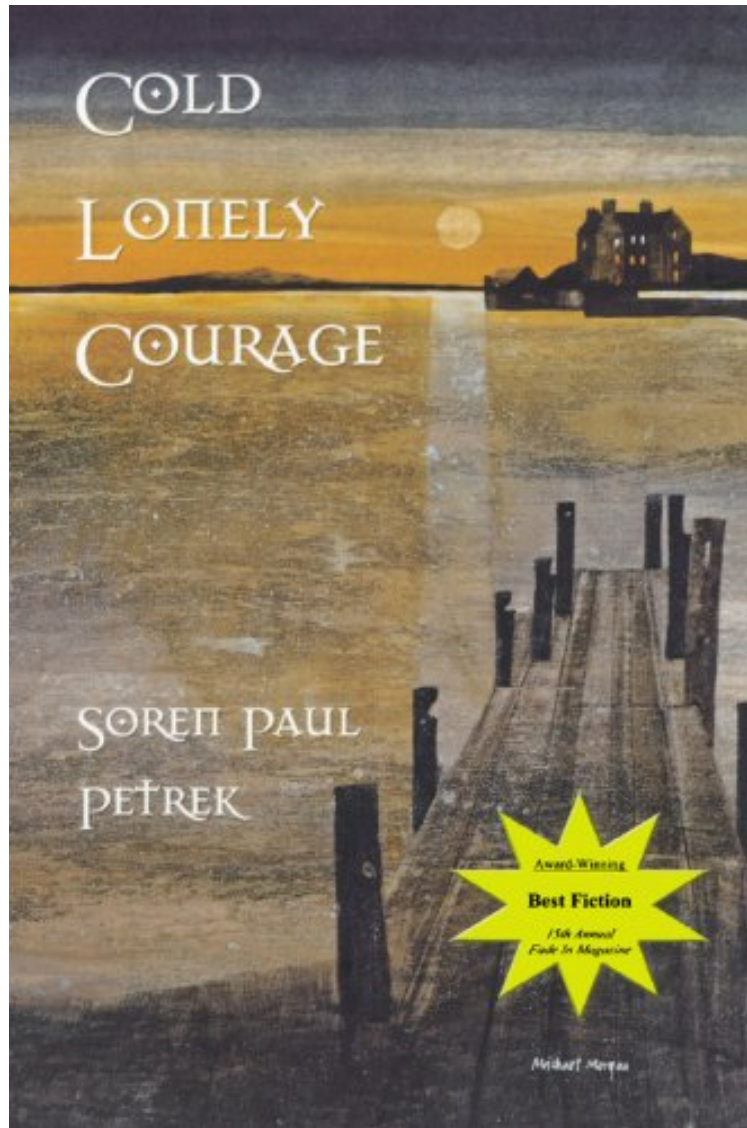

I did think the picture painted of the stereotypical French woman was a bit over the top though and there wasn't much middle-ground between her - evil Nazi and patriotic good person/hero. The story is fairly gruesome and obviously contains a lot of death, but it's not overly graphic. There were parts that had me shuddering and even one where I was close to tears, but I never felt like stop reading. All in all, it's a really good book that tells a very gripping story.
