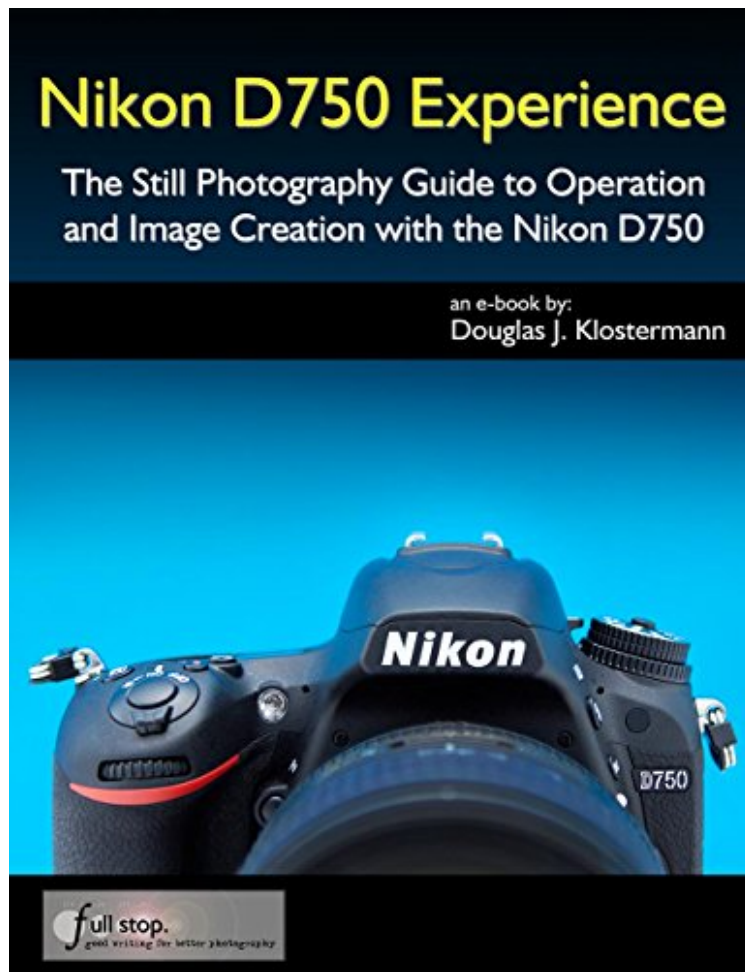

Es gibt einen guten berblick ber die Funktionalitt der neuen Kamera und weist gleichzeitig auf viele zum Teil versteckte Details hin.Z.B. habe ich aus diesem Buch gelernt, wie

man diese wunderbare Kamera dazu bewegen kann, beim Liveview das Vorschaubild auf dem Monitor nicht dunkel zu machen, wenn man eine weit geschlossene Blende vorgewählt hat. In vielen Situationen mag es hilfreich sein, wenn man im Vorschaubild gleich sieht, dass etwas mit der Belichtung nicht stimmt. Wenn man aber im Studio arbeitet, dann kann die Blende sehr geschlossen sein (damit man die notwendige Schärfentiefe bekommt), aber man will dennoch das Bild in der Vorschau beurteilen können, und dazu muss es normal hell sein. Das zur richtigen Belichtung notwendige Licht kommt dann später vom Blitzgerät. Das gesamte Menü hatte ich bereits abgesucht und nichts Geeignetes gefunden um die Kamera dazu zu bewegen das Vorschaubild hell anzuzeigen. Bis ich dann in dem Buch las, dass man diese Funktionalität in dem neuen i-MENÜ findet. Dies ist nur ein Beispiel dafür, dass auch ein ziemlich alter Hase wie ich, der vorher die ganz ähnliche Nikon D600 besessen hatte, von diesem Buch profitieren kann. Der Autor bleibt nicht dabei stehen dem Leser alle Knöpfe der Kamera zu erklären. Oft verweist er dafür einfach auf das Handbuch, das Nikon der Kamera beigelegt hat. An vielen Stellen beschreibt er, *warum* man diese oder jene Einstellung wählen sollte, wenn man diesen oder jenen Effekt erzielen möchte, oder wenn man sich an diese oder jene Situation anpassen will. Leider kommen/kamen die deutschen Bücher zur D750 einfach nicht aus den Startlöchern.
