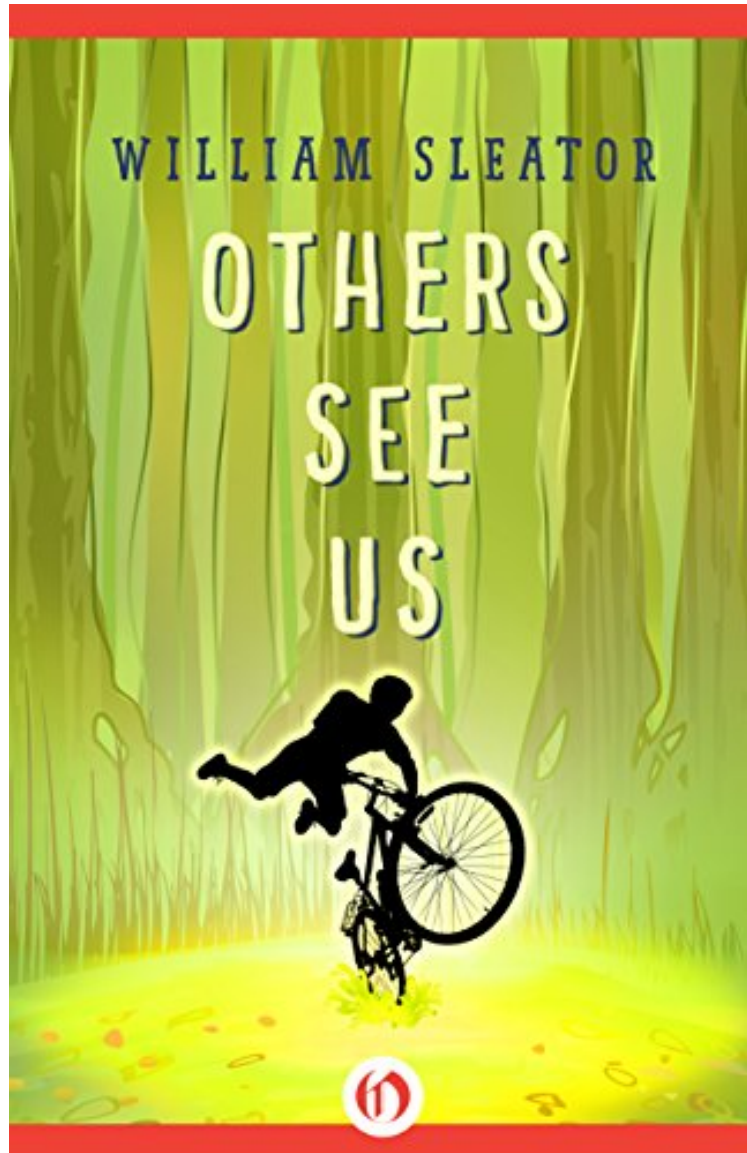

The characterization and realistic relationships between people that one expects to see from Sleator are not here in their usual degree, but the basic plot is good enough that the reader doesn't really miss it. This is partly because of Grandma, a fascinating character who gambles with people's lives for no apparent reason. Sleator associates her with spiders, and hints that they are her inions or perhaps her herself...the reader can't really tell what Sleator is getting at, but it's fascinating to think about.
