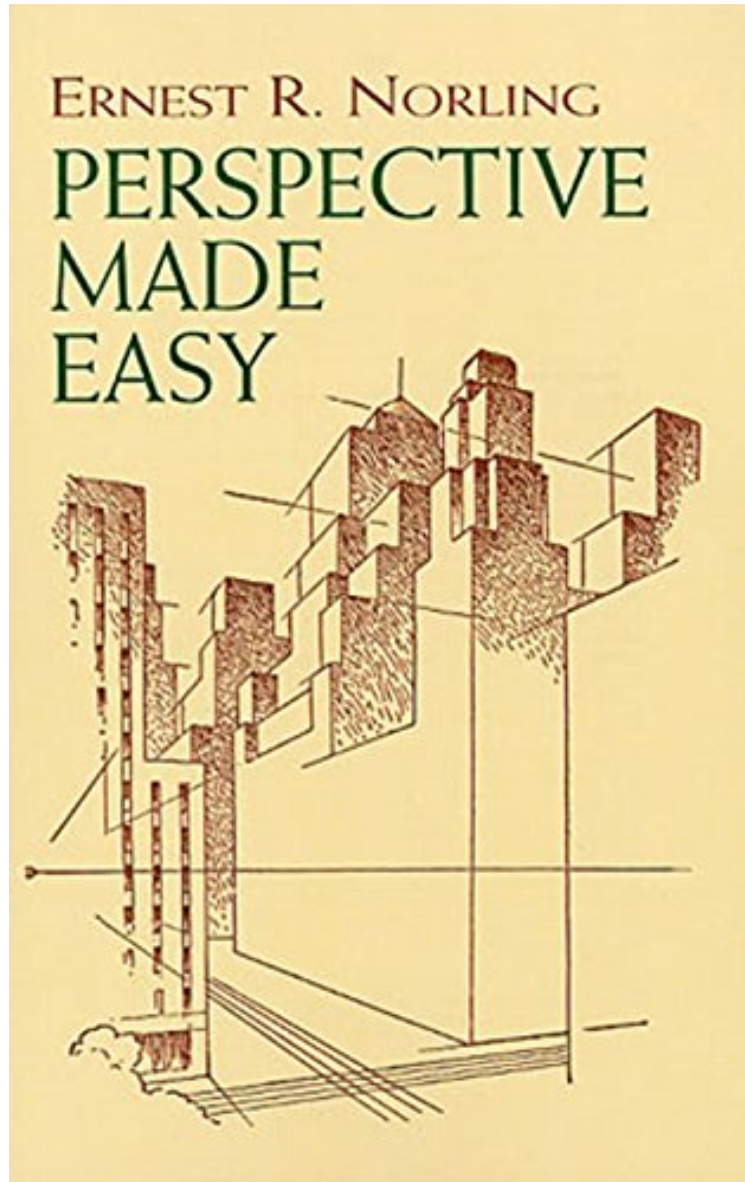

In spite of being published way back in 1939, the concepts and methods in this title are as applicable now, as then. I managed to complete reading the book in one afternoon and began practicing what I learnt that evening, and it worked. Being a Dover publication, it's reasonably priced compared to contemporary titles. As a result, I've begun a witch-hunt for other Dover books.
