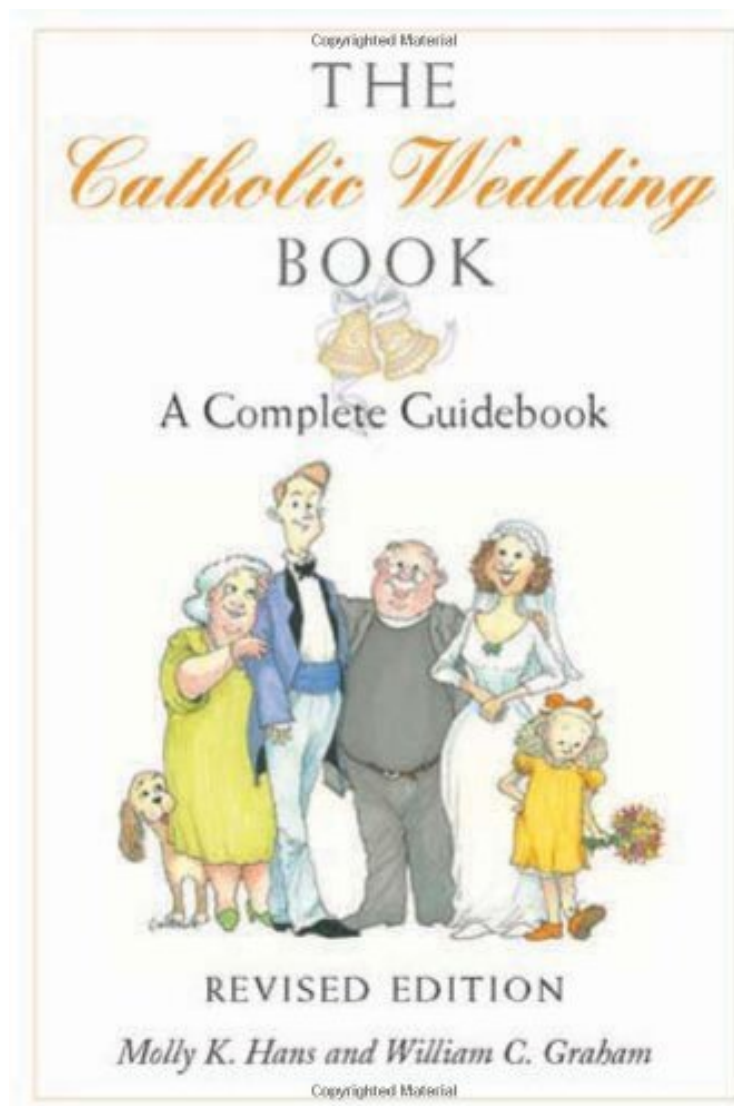

However if you are getting married in Britain (as opposed to America, where the book was written) you have very little leeway about the vows as they are covered by Act of Parliament. The "light-hearted", jokey style gets a bit irritating after a while too.
