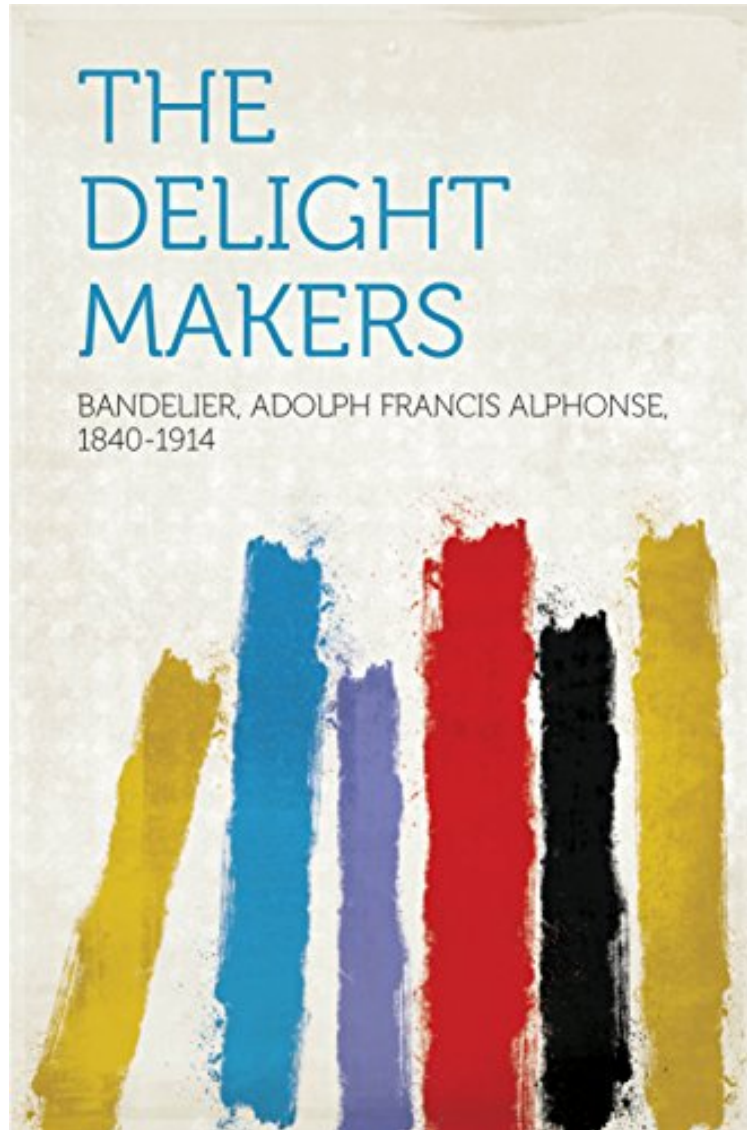

Monument near Santa Fe, New Mexico, is named after him. He sets his story in the scenic surrounding between canyons, sparkling streams, dense forests and volcanic mountains where beautiful 'Rito de los Frijoles' runs. The ruins of the Queres can today be found in the National Monument. This novel is about clan rivalry, love and hate and give us an insight, how the families in these long gone days might have lived. Bandelier delivers us a clue, why the people from the Rito might have abandoned their homes. His figures are neither only bad nor only good, they are like people are, good and bad at the same time. And Bandelier is not the scientist who describes in black and white the 'noble savage' or 'bloodthirsting Indian', he creates a society of human beings with feelings, fears and problems like today's people. The book is an fascinating adventure for everyone with prehistorical interests, the traveller of the Southwest, the Indian lover and for the reader of a good and thrilling story.
