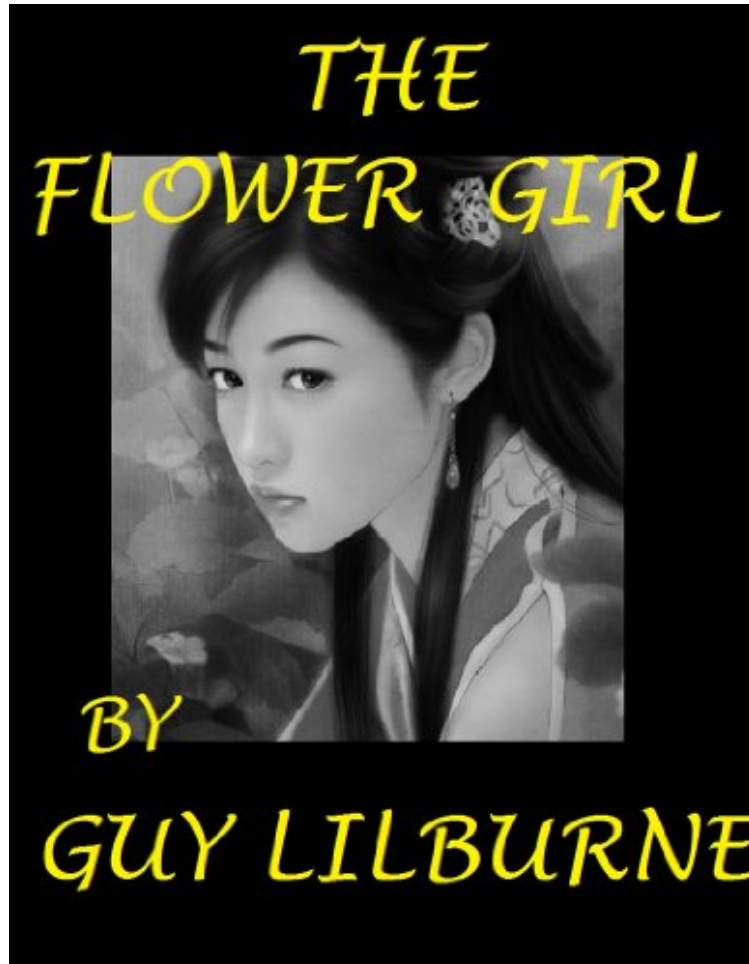

Because it gave me all I want from a good read: I liked the protagonist as well as the minor "players", the setting in Phuket is perfect because I love that island, and it was the first time someone wrote - something positive about Thai prisons! :)The story starts with Steven West, 38 years old, is leaving Manchester/England for the first time in his live. Destination: Thailand, Island of Phuket. He is not the sharpest knife in the drawer and not really ugly, but somehow ... insignificant.At first it's a bit

like watching Forest Gump meeting Suzie Wong :)After his first adventures involving bargirls, a black eye and a massage parlor, he gets himself a scooter for exploring the island. He also has gotten a certain insight about his money, Thai girls and lady drinks ...Then he meets Pin the Flower Girl. She is selling roses in the streets - and is visibly pregnant. Her Ex, a Leeds character called Dean has a tattoo and a temper, and slowly Pin opens up to Steven and tells him her sad story. Then, on one of their excursions - after visiting the Zoo and a temple where a monk gives them both his blessings and a wristlet to Steven, Pin shows him her secret place. Where the story with Dean ended once and for all...Steven's fate takes an ugly turn when the police comes to arrest him for the murder of Pin and her unborn child.
